TO ACHIEVE A LEGITIMATE OBJECTIVE UNDER CHAPTER 7
OF THE AGREEMENT ON INTERNAL TRADE**

Consumer Protection

Rationale/Justification:
Yukon uses the common law system, while Quebec uses the civil law system. There are significant foundational differences between the two systems and in the way the law is developed and codified in each. A person trained to or practice law under only one of these systems will not possess the knowledge or expertise to practice in the other system.

Additional Requirement(s):
Individual assessment of the education, credentials and experience of a member of the Barreau du Quebec who seeks certification in Yukon, to determine whether the member has the necessary common law knowledge or expertise to practice law in Yukon. If considered necessary, additional training, examinations and/or experience may be imposed as a condition of certification.
