**Rationale/Justification:** Material Scope of Practice Difference

In Saskatchewan there are three distinct areas of practice for the paramedic profession. The scopes of practice differ for the three professions with EMRs having a basic scope and EMT-P/ACPs having the broadest scope. This results in practitioners from other provinces generally not having the necessary competencies to perform the scope of practice for Saskatchewan as they do not receive training for the skills they do not perform.

**Additional Requirement(s):**

As per below the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics will require that individuals demonstrate competence/complete a course in:

EMT-PCP

- Urinary catheterization and the administration of blood and blood products.

Individual assessments of competencies will only be conducted for applicants certified in jurisdictions that do not require the same mandatory competencies as listed on [www.collegeofparamedics.sk.ca](http://www.collegeofparamedics.sk.ca). Courses are available on-line through the Alberta College of Paramedics.
