

## NOTICE OF MEASURE

to Achieve a Legitimate objective under Chapter 7 of the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA)

**Regulated Occupation Name:**

Medical Radiation Technologists

**Province(s)/Territory(ies) whose workers are affected:**

Nova Scotia

**Under which legitimate objective(s) is/are the measure(s) being filed:**

Protection of human life or health.

**Rationale/Justification:**

The scope of practice of a medical radiation technologist in New Brunswick includes 4 distinct areas each of which is issued a separate license: 1. Radiological technology, 2. nuclear medicine technology, 3. magnetic resonance technology, and 4. radiation therapy technology. In NB the area of practice is indicated on the license.

In Nova Scotia, the regulatory authority issues a general license which does not indicate the area of practice for which the worker has been trained and has acquired experience.

**Additional Requirement(s):**

The applicants will be individually assessed to determine if the applicant is qualified to practice in one or more of the 4 areas of practice that exist in New Brunswick.
