#### **Rationale/Justification:**

The scope of practice of a medical radiation technologist in New Brunswick includes 4 distinct areas each of which is issued a separate license: 1. <u>Radiological technology</u>, 2. <u>nuclear medicine technology</u>, 3. <u>magnetic resonance technology</u>, and 4. <u>radiation therapy technology</u>. In NB the area of practice is indicated on the license.

In Nova Scotia, the regulatory authority issues a general license which does not indicate the area of practice for which the worker has been trained and has acquired experience.

#### Additional Requirement(s):

The applicants will be individually assessed to determine if the applicant is qualified to practice in one or more of the 4 areas of practice that exist in New Brunswick.
