**Rationale/Justification:** Material Scope of Practice Difference

In Alberta, there are 4 distinct areas of practice for medical radiation and diagnostic technologists: radiological technologists, nuclear medicine technologists, magnetic resonance technologists, and radiation therapists. In Quebec, radiological technologists and magnetic resonance technologists are not regulated as distinct areas of practice. This legitimate objective only pertains to radiological technologists and magnetic resonance technologists.

**Additional Requirement(s):**

Individual assessment of the education credentials and experience of radiological technologists and magnetic resonance technologists from Quebec is required to determine the applicant's primary specialty and place them on the appropriate register(s).

Indefinite
